

Daily Devotion For March 20, 2021

Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again." John 3:3

This morning I received an email from Evelyn Kageyama sharing with me that her brother Gary's daughter Krista had labor induced at that she was expecting her first child.

In John 3, Nicodemus, a Pharisee came to Jesus at night and asked what he must do to receive eternal life. Jesus told him in John 3:3 that he must be born again. This was a puzzling response for Nicodemus as he asked Jesus what he must do to be born again. In John 3, Jesus was talking about a spiritual rebirth, not a physical one. The new spiritual beginning that Jesus offers is so complete, so all-encompassing, that he called it being born again.

Thought For Today: Just as we get excited at the birth of a new child, we can be excited when a loved one is born again into the family of God by faith in Jesus. Have you been born again? Who are you praying for that they might be born again?
