For our Thursday evening Bible discussion we talked about the history of the Catholic Church as well as the Protestant Reformation. In 1517, Martin Luther posted his 95 theses to the Wittenberg Door in Germany, thus starting the Protestant Reformation. The story of Martin Luther demonstrates how **one person can make a difference.**

One current example of how Martin Luther’s life continues to **make a difference** is through the lives of Civil Rights Leaders Martin Luther King Jr. and his father Martin Luther King Sr. Did you know that Martin Luther King Sr. was born Michael King Sr. and his son was born Michael King Jr.? But while on a trip to Germany, Michael King Sr. was so impressed with the life of Martin Luther that upon returning back to the states changed his name to Martin Luther King Sr. and had his son’s name changed to Martin Luther King Jr.

It has been over 500 years since the Protestant Reformation, but the life of Martin Luther continues **to make a difference** in the battle for civil rights among African Americans in the United States and around the world.
