## **THE BATTLE HYMN OF THE REPUBLIC**

### **What is the story behind the Battle Hymn of the Republic?**

Officers of the 5th U.S. Cavalry near Washington, D.C., in 1865. Julia Ward Howe was inspired to write "The **Battle Hymn of the Republic**" after a visit with Union troops in the thick of the Civil War. ... The real **history** on that point is clear: Julia Ward Howe wrote the song as a pro-Union, **anti-slavery anthem**.
