Christmas for Christ Christmas 2022

Dear El Estero Church Family and Friends;

As we turn the calendar once again that brings us to the celebration of Christ's birth, the question that I am asking is, "Why can't Christmas be more like Thanksgiving?" No, I don't mean being stuffed with turkey and all the other delicious foods that we

consume this time of the year. When you think about it, with very few exceptions, the world of advertising has restrained themselves from commercializing on Thanksgiving. Thanksgiving is a pretty strait-forward holiday, an honest celebration. Thanksgiving, if we choose, is a time to sit back and reflect upon the wonderful blessings that God has so richly bestowed upon us.

For generations, the recipe for Thanksgiving has included roast turkey and dressings, liberally applied to a mixture of relatives and friends. Families gather together to talk, laugh, watch football games, all the way through their helpings of turkey, cranberries, pies, and cakes.

The ingredients for Thanksgiving have not changed much through the centuries. We have not added any overweight, bearded, midnight chimney sweeps bearing gifts or forest creatures pulling sleighs through the fog. May Christmas be Thanksgiving, Thanksgiving for the Incarnate Word, for Jesus the Christ, for the holy and anointed one of God, the Savior, the Great High Priest, the Wonderful Counselor, The Almighty God, the Everlasting Father, and the Prince of Peace.
