The First Commandment:

<sup>3</sup> "You shall have no other gods before <sup>[a]</sup> me. <sup>4</sup> "You shall not make for yourself an **idol** in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. <sup>5</sup> You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a **jealous** God," Exodus 20:3-5

Bring my sons from afar and my daughters from the ends of the earth- <sup>7</sup> everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for my **glory**, whom I formed and made." Isaiah 43:6-7

Glorifying God means Revealing God To Others so That They Can See God More Clearly.

4] "I have brought you **glory** on earth by completing the work you gave me to do...." 6] I have revealed you to those whom you gave me." John 17:4, 6

<sup>14</sup>"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup>Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. <sup>16</sup>In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they **may see** your good deeds and **praise your Father in heaven.**
