With a Thanksgiving Potluck on Sunday, November 19, 2023, After worship service in the Fellowship Hall.


The church's Outreach Committee will provide pumpkin pies and whipped cream for dessert.

Watch for news of the January Hiking Fellowship in the January Echoes.


