"But <u>rejoice</u> that you participate in the sufferings of Christ." I Peter 4:13a (NIV)

Reasons to Rejoice

□ It ______to Christ. "...these trials will make you <u>partners</u> with <u>Christ</u> in his suffering, and afterwards you will have the wonderful joy of sharing his glory." I Pet. 4:13b (LB)

□ It means God

3. _____ TO BE ASHAMED.

"If you suffer <u>as a Christian</u>, do not be ashamed, but praise God that you bear that name." I Pet. 4:16 (NIV

"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5:10

4. _____ FAITHFUL TO GOD!

"So then, those who suffer according to God's will should <u>commit themselves to their faithful</u> <u>Creator and</u> <u>continue to do good</u>." I Peter 4:19 (NIV)
