GOOD NEWS!!

During our Fellowship Time on Friday, the question was asked, why do we call Good Friday "good', when it was the death of our Lord Jesus on the cross. My response was, without the "bad" news of Jesus death on the cross, the good news of the gospel would have no meaning. The bad news of Jesus paying the penalty for our sins at the cross of Calvary turned to "good news" three days later as Jesus conquered sin and

abolished death and offers eternal life to all those who put their hope, faith and trust in Him.

This is the reason that Easter has so much meaning and significance for us as believers in Jesus. This is the Good News of the Gospel. When we turn on the news these days we hear so much of the war in Ukraine, the news of murders across the country, the continuing number of covid infections, and the list goes on and on. But amidst all of the bad news, Easter is the time for us to remember the greatest good news the world has ever known.

As we look towards the celebration of Easter, I pray that the hearts of each one of us will also be open to truly celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. The resurrection is the heart of our Christian faith. Without the resurrection, there would be no forgiveness of sins and no hope for eternal life. Most of all, there would be no hope to be in an intimate relationship with the living God.

For many people, death is the most dreaded experience of all of life. We don't like to think about death. Yet death is something is one day we must all participate in. The Bible teaches that because Jesus does live, that He rose from the dead, death is swallowed up in victory. We need no longer fear death. This is why Easter is such a great time of joy and celebration for Christians around the world.

As we celebrate Easter for the first time in two years in our church sanctuary, I pray that you not only come to know the forgiveness through the shed blood of Jesus on the cross and hope of eternal life, but the joy of being in an intimate relationship with a loving and personal God. May each of our hearts be open to celebrate this Good News!




