A. The Background:

Paul and Silas in Berea:

¹⁰ As soon as it was night, the believers sent Paul and Silas away to **Berea**. On arriving there, **they went to the Jewish synagogue**. Acts 17:10

The Berean's Character:

¹¹ Now the Berean Jews were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.

B. Lessons From The Berean's

1.) The Berean's Submitted To The Authority of the Scriptures:

"They received the message with great **eagerness**." Vs. 11

The Bible is the supreme and sole authority on matters of faith and conduct.

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work." 2 Timothy 3:16-17

2.) The Berean's Examined The Scriptures Daily

"They received the message with great eagerness and **examined** the Scriptures **every day** to see if what Paul said was true." Vs. 11

3.) The Berean's Immediate Obedience

As a result, many of them **believed**, as did also a number of prominent Greek women and many Greek men." Vs. 12
