

Daily Devotion For November 17, 2022

¹⁴ But I trust in you, LORD; I say, "You are my God." ¹⁵ My times are in your hands;...." Psalm 31:14-15

Two weeks ago we set our clock's back one hour as daylight savings time came to an end. I was reminded of that when I was at the gym and saw a clock whose time had not been reset.

It is late afternoon as I write this devotion and already I see sun setting and by dinner time it will be dark. Time is one of those intriguing subjects. Someone once said, "see how fast time flies". Yet for others, time moves as slow as a glacier, especially when you're are sick or mourning or grieving the loss of a loved one. And, have you ever noticed that two weeks on vacation is different than two weeks on a diet? Sometimes it seems like time is "dragging." Deadlines arrive too quickly, prayers are not being answered according to our timetable, etc. In those times, Psalm 31:14 says ¹⁴ But I trust in you, LORD; I say, "You are my God." In Psalm 31:15 we read that "our times are in the hands of the Lord."
