Last night I send out an email from Yvonne Han asking prayers for May Wong and her family. Let me remind you of the families prayer request:

Dear friends and family,  
Rick and I are up in Monterey seeing mom, probably for the last time. At the suggestion of mom's caregivers at her Assisted Living, and her Hospice nurse, we arrived Sunday. We'll be here through this Friday, leaving Saturday.

The last time we were up here was early December to celebrate her 96th birthday with her. Even at that time, she was completely bedridden, as she has been since September. She slept much of the time, but when she was awake, her spirits were high and she was alert. However, the month following our visit, the updates I was getting from her caregivers indicated a steady decline. I noticed the change too. When I called her she was barely audible and incomprehensible, until she was unable to respond at all.

The Assisted Living facility is on lockdown due to several covid cases in another part of the community. Rick & I are allowed admittance with proof of booster shots, negative covid test, and being immediate family members for those nearing end-of-life. She is comfortable and looks peaceful. This is the goal at this point. Only God knows when he's going to have her join him in Heaven.

I have disconnected her phone service. I will keep you updated with any changes.
