**Paul and Silas in Berea:** <sup>10</sup>“As soon as it was night, the believers sent Paul and Silas away to **Berea**. On arriving there, **they went to the Jewish synagogue**. Acts 17:10

**The Berean’s Character:** <sup>11</sup> Now **the Berean Jews were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica**, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.

##### **1.) The Berean’s Submitted To The Authority of the Scriptures:**

“They received the message with great **eagerness**.”

"They received the message with great eagerness and **examined** the Scriptures **every day** to see if what Paul said was true." Vs. 11
