Much of the day I had her Alexa device playing relaxing piano hymns for her, hoping it was reaching the depths of her consciousness and soothing her soul.

Rick and I drove back home yesterday. I need to wrap up a few things at my office, and then we'll be driving back to Monterey next weekend to clean out mom's apartment.

My mom's wish was that there would be no service. I'm sure she would want you to remember her with a joyful heart and how she would love and guide with gentle compassion backed with wisdom and strength.
