Daily Devotion For January 13, 2022

God also said to Moses, "I Am the Lord." Exodus 6:2

This evening we will begin a new bible study series on the life of Moses. If you are familiar with the story of Moses you remember that Pharoah became angry at God's demand to release the Israelites from their slavery in Egypt and he greatly increased his oppression of Israel. That in turn caused the Israelites to accuse Moses of adding to their problems.

Moses was confused and wondered if God really was in charge of his life and situations. How could God place him in a position where he was seeking to do the will of God and yet encounter so much criticism. Did God forget him?

We all have moments of doubt. Even when we believe we are in the will of God things may not turn out the way that we expect. Was Moses expecting that God would help him lead the Israelites out of Egypt without any trials or difficulties? Did Moses want to quit, give up, and go back to shepherding sheep?

Behind the scenes God was moving and working in Moses life. God was preparing him to do things that Moses never would have thought or imagined. In Exodus 6:2, God reminded Moses, "I am the Lord".
