"Without Fellowship with God, We Are Drawn More to Sin."

What impact has sin had on us?

1. Sin brought about a separation in our relationship with God.

2. Sin has affected our relationship with ourselves.

3. Sin has changed our relationship with others.

4. We should seek fellowship with God.
