"You bless all who depend on you for their strength." Psalm 84:5

I've been feeling a little bit weak the past several days. I don't know if it is a summer cold or not but I have had a sore throat, achy body, coughing and sneezing. If you joined us for church yesterday, you probably noticed that I was a bit hoarse when I spoke.

I think a lot of us can relate to this right now. The ongoing warnings of Covid 19 has made some of us feeling exhausted and weak, whether it's emotionally, spiritually, or physically. You may be so weak that you can't even pray or read and study the Bible. What do you do in those moments? You rest in the strength of the Lord, "And in his arms, like a little child, you trust."

Our strength is limited. But God's strength is unlimited. Our strength is finite. But God's strength is infinite. Our strength is exhaustible. But God's strength is inexhaustible. God never runs out of energy. God never gets tired.
