When I heard of the shark attack I thought of Bethany Hamilton. Do you remember her? Her story is chronicled in the movie "Soul Surfer." When Bethany was 13, she had her left arm bitten off along the shores of Kauai. Despite losing an arm, Bethany went on to fulfill her dream of becoming a professional surfer. Bethany has also written a book entitled "Rise Above" a 90 day devotional that chronicles the life lessons she learned through the shark attack.

In the movie "Soul Surfer" Bethany bears testimony to the unique way that God has used her to tell others about Jesus. She says, "God is working in and through me. And it's pretty awesome to be a part of that."
