¹⁸ And he is **the head of the body, the church**; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that **in everything he might have the supremacy.**” Colossian 1:18

¹⁹ For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, ²⁰ and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by **making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.**” Colossians 1:19-20
